



## Abel Moreno Perez

August 26, 1932 - December 5, 2021

Abel Moreno Perez, age 89, passed away peacefully Sunday, December 5, 2021, at home surrounded by his family in Aurora, Il., after a courageous battle with Parkinson Disease and liver cancer, complicated by osteomyelitis and septicemia. At 17 years old, he immigrated to California, settling in Aurora, Il, meeting his wife Josephine Silva of 63 years.
