Albert Cinto, Sr., 92, of Aurora, passed away Friday, March 8, 2019 in Aurora, IL. He was born February 5, 1927 in Aurora, IL.

Al was a lifelong resident of Aurora and a veteran of two wars with two branches of service. He was a railroad man who worked for the Burlington Railroad for 48 years. While working at the railroad, he was interrupted twice by service to his country.

Albert served in the Merchant Marines during WWII. He also served in the United States Army during the Korean War and received double Purple Hearts. Albert was a long time member of St. George Church and very active at the St. George Church Citizen's Club functions. He loved to travel and was an avid deer hunter.

Al was also a member of Amvets, Lucky 50, the Phoenix Club, and a lifetime member of the V.F.W. in Montgomery, IL. He loved attending the Fox Valley Veterans Breakfast Club and in the past, was Veteran of the Month.

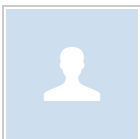
