Blaire Irene Bobo, 90, aunt, sister, daughter, disciple and friend, passed away peacefully at her home in Aurora. 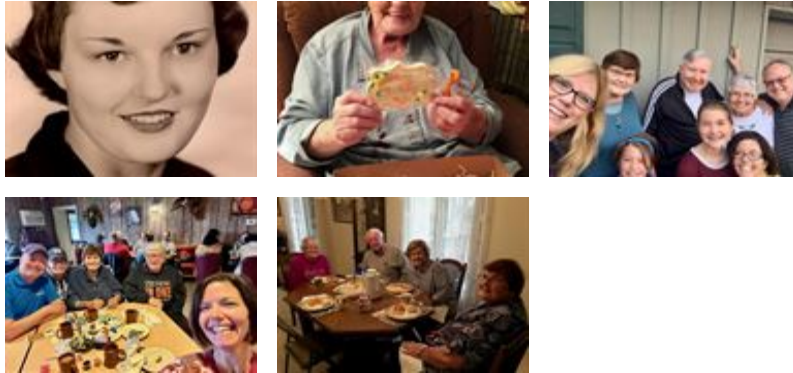
