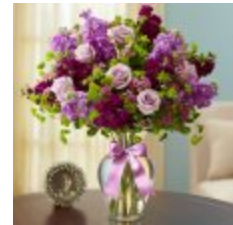

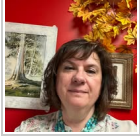

I am so grateful to have been her next door neighbor and friend for the past 15 years.

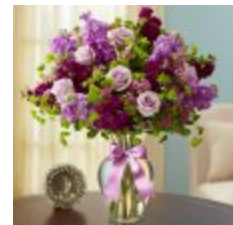
