I was sad the day Charlene and Ed moved away.*

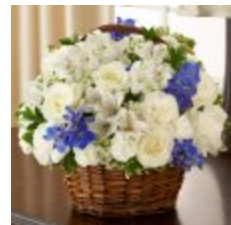
We found out about Charlene passing away from another neighbor who read it in the paper. We are not sure what happened but we will miss her dearly.
