Constance Adolph, of North Aurora, died Thursday, August 6, 2015 at Presence Mercy Medical Center in Aurora. Connie was born November 7, 1936 in Bloomington, and grew up there and in Elgin. She married June 23, 1957, and then graduated from ISNU (now ISU) in June, 1959. Her first position was at Jefferson Junior High, teaching Speech and Geography.

Connie served on the National Board of the YWCA of the USA from the mid-sixties until 1979, participating in three national conventions and making many trips to assist and assess local YW's in the Midwest. She furthered the YW's then-new mission: Eliminate Racism, by Any Means Necessary."

Connie returned to teaching, at West High, at both North and South Campuses: U.S. History and Consumer Economics.
