It is with great sadness that our Mom, Corenne Antoinette Fredericksen (Seidelman), was called home on Saturday, May 11, 2024 at Rush Copley Hospital. She was on the road to recovery after suffering a stroke last month, but an unexpected illness was more than her 92 year old body could handle. Corenne was born on March 4, 1932 in Aurora Il, attended St. Joseph grade school and graduated from Madonna High School in 1950. She married the love of her life on Oct. 17th, 1959 and after 18 wonderful and loving years of marriage, became a widow on Jan. 1st, 1978 when our Dad was called home. She blessed us with quality catholic education, strong family values, endless generosity and a lifetime of cherished memories that we will carry and share for the rest of our days. 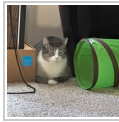
