



## Cyril F. Byrne

April 23, 1936 - January 8, 2019

Cyril F. Byrne, 82 of Oswego passed away Tuesday, January 8, 2019 at Rush Copley Memorial Hospital. He was born April 23, 1936 to the late Cyril and Augusta (Hopingjon) Byrne in Cuba City, WI.

Cyril was united in marriage to Sarah E. Byrne on November 8, 1958 at St. Rose Catholic Church in Cuba City, WI, after having served in the United States Air Force from 1955 to 1978. During his 23 year Air Force career, Cyril had various positions and titles. He was a crewman on a C5A Galaxy, worked in Strategic Air Command (SAC), and was a Civil Engineer with Tactical Air Command (TAC). Cyril was stationed in various locations throughout the world, Bermuda, Alaska, Spain, Turkey, and Taiwan. Stateside St Paul, MN. San Antonio TX. Topeka KS. Grand Forks ND. Long Island NY. Oklahoma City OK. Kincheloe AFB MI. and March AFB CA. Cyril retired from the Air Force out of March Air Force Base California and moved to Oswego IL where he worked another 20 years at Richard Wilcox as an assembler, in Aurora IL.

Survivors are four children, Cyrilla Byrne, Cassandra (Douglas) Gulick, John Byrne and Tommy (Tina) Byrne; nine grandchildren and eleven great grandchildren and his brother Patrick Byrne. He was preceded in death by his wife of 56 years Sarah E. Byrne and by his parents; ten siblings Richard, Elloise, Ann, Sue, Jimmy, Jean, Beth, Sally, Mary Ellen, Joe.

Funeral Mass will be offered Monday, January 14th, 2019 at 10:00 am at St. Anne Church, 551 Boulder Hill Pass, Oswego, IL. Fr. John Ouper will officiate with interment in Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery in Elwood, IL.

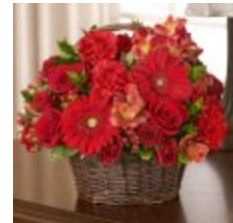
