Daniel A. Gorman, 68, of Aurora, passed away Friday, July 29, 2016 at his home. He was born February 5, 1948 in Chicago, Illinois.

Daniel was a graduate of Weber High School in Chicago and graduated from University of Illinois with a Bachelor's degree in mathematics. His family attended Stanislaus Kosta Church in Chicago. Daniel was a multi-decorated Combat Medic U.S. Army veteran of Viet Nam, including the Combat Medical Badge. He was employed with R.R. Street as a Director of Purchasing for many years until his retirement. Daniel was a member of the Waidley Aurora V.F.W. Post #468, the Aurora Am Vets Post #103, and was a member of the St. George Social Club.

Survivors include his daughter, Katy Gorman of Aurora; his brother, Joseph (Judy) Gorman of The Villages, FL; his sister, Pamela (Walt) Smith of N Milford, Delaware; three nephews, David and James Gorman and Josh Smith; and his cat, Annie.
