



## Eduardo Ramirez

November 20, 1959 - January 31, 2013

Eduardo Ramirez, Jr., 53, passed away Thursday, January 31, at Reynolds Army Hospital in Lawton, OK. He was born November 20, 1959.

Eduardo was a graduate of East Aurora High School in 1977. He served in the Armed Forces from 1978 – 1981. Eduardo went to Seminary School in 1984 and became a Reverend. He married his wife Yvonne on October 7, 1983. He did missionary work overseas for 17 years in Germany, Korea, and The Philippines as well as across the United States. In 2003 he became a Permanent Resident Reverend in Lawton Oklahoma for New Testament Christian Church until his passing.

He is survived by his loving wife, Yvonne; his parents, Eduardo Sr. and Wilma Maria; one brother, Ismael and one sister, Ana (Gerardo) Ramirez-Ramos; 3 nieces, Sheena, Jessica and Sarah; and 3 nephews, Miguel, Julian, and Ismael; one great niece Sofia.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Isabel and Enrique Ramirez.
