Edward Peters, 87 of Aurora, was surrounded by his loving family when he passed away at his home on Thursday, November 22, 2012. He was born in Aurora, IL to the late Fred and Lillian (Poss) Peters.

He is survived his wife, Jane Ann (Feiden) and six children, Sheila (Dave) White, Father Dan Peters, Jo (Mike) Klein, Diane (Brad) Hansen, Fred (Beth) Peters, and Greg (Ellen) Peters. He is also survived by his nephew, Steve (Holly) West, 23 grandchildren, and 23 great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his sister Rita (Don) West and nephew Mike West.

On June 18, 1949 he married Jane Ann Feiden and they spent the next 63 years together. Ed was a member of the greatest generation, a Navy veteran, that traveled to all areas of the South Pacific. He was a signalman on a 5-man amphibious landing craft (L.C.M.). He was involved in the first wave of D-day to hit the beach at Okinawa on Easter morning, April 1, 1945. He served aboard the U.S.S. Caswell A.K.A. 72. He owned and operated Ed Peters Realty for many years. Ed was a lifetime member and color guard for the Montgomery VFW Post 7452. Ed was a member of the Luxemburger Club, Lucky 50 Club, and served as President of the Serra Club. He was a lifetime parishioner of St. Nicholas Church. Ed enjoyed many years of fishing with

family and friends on Lake Delevan.

The family will be greeting guests at St. Nicholas Church in Aurora on Tuesday, November 27, 2012 from 9:00AM until 11:00 AM. A memorial mass will be celebrated at 11:00 AM following the visitation on Tuesday.
