Dorothy “Eileen” Scanlan, 90, passed away on Sunday, March 20, 2016 in Bonita Springs FL after a courageous bout with cancer.

Eileen spent the last 27 years in Florida after retiring there with her husband Jack. Eileen was born to Peter and Mary Schweisthal, the youngest of ten children. She received her nursing degree from Mercy Hospital and enjoyed a nursing career at a number of different hospitals and facilities for many years. Eileen met her future husband Jack while working in Chicago. They were married in 1949 and had three children – Kathy, Shari, and Jay.
