Elizabeth "Betty" Madar Stanciu, 89, of North Aurora, formally of Aurora, IL, died peacefully on June 2nd, 2016. Betty was preceded in death by her parents John and Julia Madar. She is survived by her loving husband, Dan Stanciu, Jr. and their five children. Betty graduated from Aurora East High School in 1944. She went on to attend Gregg Business School in Chicago, IL. Upon graduation she went to work as a secretary for the Illinois Unemployment Compensation Division in Aurora, IL. Betty and Dan met in June 1949, in Aurora, IL. They were married on June 15, 1952, at St. George Byzantine Catholic Church. While Dan attended Purdue University School of Pharmacy, Betty worked at the university for Dr. George E. Davis in the Adult Education Division and for the President Emeritus, Dr. E.C. Elliot. Betty and Dan settled down in Aurora, IL in 1957. Dan went to work for Colonial Drugs that year and in 1958, he purchased the business. Betty worked part time at Colonial Drugs and loved taking care of the greeting card section, while raising the children of their growing family. Betty enjoyed playing tennis and golf at The Aurora Country Club, where she and Dan were members from 1964 to 1995. She was proud of her "hole in one" she made at Bliss Creek Golf Course, which was quite an accomplishment. Betty also enjoyed baking and cooking for large family gatherings, friends, and church events.
