Ernest G. Frieders, 91, of Oswego, formerly of Marseilles and Naperville, Illinois died at Rush Copley Medical Center on November 16, 2020. He was born September 22, 1929 in Aurora, the son of Peter and Elizabeth (Bohr) Frieders. On March 31, 1951 he married Dolores Schweisthal who passed away in October of 1994.
