Fredric W. Prill, age 82, of Aurora, passed away on May 9, 2019 in Aurora. He was born on October 1, 1936 in LaGrange, Indiana to Harold and Mildred Prill. 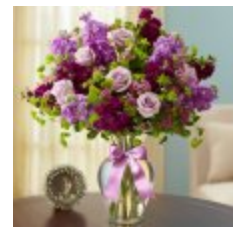
