George F. Olinger, 89, of Aurora, passed away Wednesday, June 24, 2015, at Presence Mercy Medical Center. He was born May 3, 1926 in Aurora, Illinois.

George was a lifelong Aurora resident. He graduated from Marmion Military Academy and Loras College in Iowa. George excelled at basketball, playing for Marmion and Loras and served as the Marmion team captain under Coach George Ireland who went on to coach Loyola of Chicago to the 1963 NCAA Championship. After graduating from Loras, George worked as a chemist for Sinclair Oil. He was later employed as salesman in the auto industry and finally worked for School District 203 in Naperville.
