Ignaz "Iggy" Wurst, 85, of Bristol, passed away peacefully at his home Saturday, Nov. 17, surrounded by loved ones. He was born in Hungary on Nov. 2, 1927 to parents Andreas and Katharina (Edl) Wurst.

In 1952 Iggy came to the United States from Germany. He settled down in Aurora, where he started his family. Working as a bricklayer, Iggy spent many years working on construction projects throughout the Fox Valley.
