



Jack "Duffy" Lindstrom

December 12, 1933 - October 15, 2015

Jack "Duffy" Lindstrom, 81, of Aurora, passed away October 15, 2015 at Presence Mercy Center. He was born December 12, 1933 in Evanston, IL to John and Olive Lindstrom, Sr. The family moved to Aurora in 1941.

Jack graduated from West Aurora High School in 1951, where he earned all-state honors in football. He attended Iowa State University, where he met his future wife, Ellen, and graduated in 1955. They were married April 28, 1956. He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1956-1959 as an aircraft maintenance officer. He then returned to Aurora with his family to join his father's business, Custom Door Company. It later became Lindstrom's Kitchens. Jack was the owner and president until his retirement in 2012. He was very active in the community, serving on numerous charitable and service boards. He was a member of Kiwanis International for many years and served as Lord Mayor of Prestbury. He will be remembered for his sense of humor and devotion to his family, friends, sports (especially golf) and travel.

He is survived by his loving wife of 59 ½ years, Ellen; his sons Thomas (Donna) of Sugar Grove and David of New York City; granddaughters Chelsey and Ava; brother James (Patricia) and nephew Ron (Janet) of Aurora; and 11 grand nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents; John Sr. and Olive; his daughter

Suzanne, and nephew Lannie Lindstrom.

In accordance with his wishes, there was no visitation. The family will welcome friends at a celebration of Jack's life on Wednesday, November 4, 2015 from 4:00pm until 8:00pm in the Pine Room at Bliss Creek Golf Course.
