Jacqueline Mae Vance, 85, of Aurora, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by her family on Tuesday, July 26, 2016. She was born March 29, 1931 to John and Mae (Modoff) McCarty.

Raised in Aurora, Mom attended East Aurora Schools and graduated from the elite Nursing program at St. Charles Hospital in Aurora. She began her Nursing career working at Silver Cross, St. Charles, Copley and Geneva Community Hospitals. At the pinnacle of her nursing career she obtained the title of Director of Surgical Nursing, a position which she retired from in 1986.

While celebrating her graduation in downtown Aurora, a chance encounter with a handsome fella, Gordon Vance, started a lifelong love affair lasting 60 years. Their story began in Joliet, but they were called home to Aurora in 1959, purchasing the largest house available for their growing family. They raised seven children in their High Street home, a central location for many of the kid's friends. In addition, Mom held Saturday morning "Kids Church" for all of the Grandkids, teaching them the word of God, songs and activities. In return the Grandkids received many memories to cherish and gave their parents much needed time off. Mom lived a full and wonderful life, giving advice and love to her children, hugs and kisses to the youngsters and smiles and warmth to everyone she

met.
