Just know Jeff was a good man and we have many fond memories of him and his family members. May God be with you all and He has called one of his good servants to rest and peace in his Kingdom.

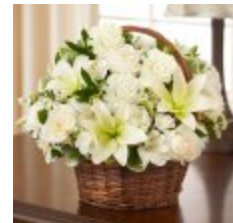
We are unfortunately out of town this week or we would have attended the final services for Jeff.
