Jose Raymundo Saltijeral, 52, of Aurora, passed away Friday, July 29, 2016 at his home. He was born July 26, 1964 in Aurora, Illinois.

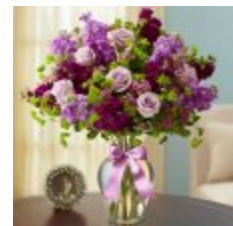
