Laurie Ogren Feltes, 89, passed away Friday, May 12, 2017, at the Michealsen Health Center in Batavia. She was born March 27, 1928 in Chicago, Illinois, the daughter of Lodorsa and Roy Ogren.

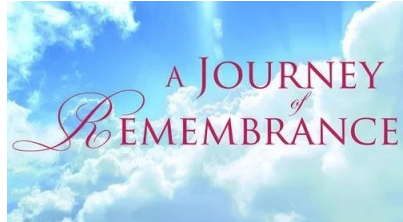
