LeRoy H. Ringler was welcomed into Heaven on Sunday, February 25, 2018. He died peacefully in his sleep. He was born September 18, 1939 in Dixon, Illinois to Minnie Esther Gottel and Harold Leroy Ringler.

LeRoy graduated from Dixon High School and went to work for Caterpillar in Montgomery, Illinois in 1958. He served proudly in the United States Army for 2 years in the 60's, then returned to Caterpillar until 1992 when he retired.

Upon retirement he became busier than ever and remained so, right through his very last day here on Earth! LeRoy's first venture after retirement was to run the stamp store he and Susan purchased in Oswego, Illinois, where he made many new friends and loved running the store.

LeRoy was an active member of Bob's Hill Troop 3 at New England Congregational Church. He was an Assistant Scoutmaster, a Crew 88 Committee Member, and served on the Foxfire District Special Needs Committee. LeRoy received The Geezer of the Year Award, the Order of the Arrow Award, the District Award of Merit, and the Unit Hero, which is awarded by his troop and crew.

LeRoy was an active member in his church of 30+ years, New Life Church, where he served with passion as a Sunday school teacher with the

preschoolers, a vacation bible school volunteer, and an active member of Evergreen's Senior Group.

LeRoy had his cherished weekly coffee clutch, and amazing fishing trips a few times a year, with dear pals.

He is survived by his loving wife of 28 years, Susan Ringler; his nephews, Daniel and Thomas Newsome, whom he lovingly helped raise; his sister, Shirley (Don) Raney of DeKalb; his mother-in-law, Ileene Newsome; his brother-in-law, Ken Newsome; and his sister-in-law, Kathy Jo Newsome.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Harold and Minnie Ringler; his dear friend and father-in-law, Ron Newsome; several aunts and uncles; and his first wife, Sharron K. Ringler.
