Lois M. Frerich, 91, of Batavia (formerly of Aurora) passed away on April 7, 2022. She was born Dec. 14, 1930 in Litchfield, Minnesota to Arthur and Margaret Kielty. On June 14, 1958 she was united in marriage to David D. Frerich. They were married for 61 years. Together they raised four children and her example instilled in them a love of faith and family.

Lois graduated from St. Cloud State University, MN with a B.S. Degree in Elementary Education and taught elementary grades for 9 years in MN. (three of those years were in one-room country schools with students in grades 1-8.) The next 19 years were spent raising her children. She returned to the field of education as an academic aide at Waldo Junior High (8 years) and as a library aide at Aurora East HS (8 years). In 1994 she retired to enjoy her family and grandchildren. She and Dave also enjoyed many trips to Florida getting away from Illinois winters.

She was a longtime member of Annunciation Church, a member of Altar Rosary Sodality, Retired Teachers Asso., Annunciation VIP, and a member of a bridge group of close friends for over 40 years.
