Marguerite "Marge" Ann Bryan, 86, of Aurora passed away Thursday, October 15, 2020 at her home. She was born August 10, 1934 in Aurora, IL.

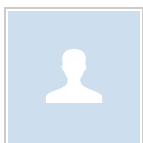
