Mark C. Lowney, 45 of Aurora, passed away Monday, March 21, 2016 at Holy Family Medical Center in DesPlaines, surrounded by his family and loved ones. He was born October 12, 1970 in Aurora.

Mark answered to many names; “Spanky”, “Sparkles”, “Marky Mark”, “Clowney”, among others that can’t be mentioned. He was always the life of the party. His huge heart, quick wit and infectious laugh would fill the room with smiles. He was truly larger than life and put everyone around him in a good mood. Mark was an avid fisherman and looked forward to his yearly trips to Canada with his Dad. He bowled with his Dad in several leagues over the years and was a phenomenal pool player. Some of his happiest years were playing pool on various teams in the area leagues. Among his favorites was the “Q-Balls” for which he played for over fifteen years. You always knew when Mark had kept score as he would routinely draw Q-Ball cartoons on the scoresheets. Mark was very creative and talented and would happily admit to anyone that he loved flowers. He had the knack to recite movie lines at the most appropriate time, always making people laugh. Mark was a great friend to so many, and he will be deeply missed.

Mark was a member of the Third Ward club and the Aurora Athletic Club for many years. He was proud to be a graduate of Holy Angels Grade School in 1984 and of Aurora Central Catholic High School in 1988. He served his apprenticeship with Sheet Metal Union Local #265, and began his lifelong career in his family’s business, Gengler-Lowney Laser Works, where he

specialized in the intricate working of the laser machine.
