



## Mary Ann T. Jacobsen

March 5, 1927 - November 17, 2016

Mary Ann Jacobsen, 89, of Aurora passed away peacefully on Thursday, November 17 at Sunnymere in Aurora, Illinois. She was born March 5, 1927 in St. Helena, Nebraska.

Upon graduating from high school, Mary Ann enrolled in the United States Cadet Nurse Corps training program at Presentation College in Aberdeen, South Dakota. She began her nursing career at Hand County Hospital in Miller, South Dakota, transferred to Copley Memorial Hospital in Aurora in 1949, paused in 1951 to raise her children, and returned to nursing in 1965 until the time of her retirement in 1995.

Mary Ann lived a life devoted to God and service to humanity. She was a member of Our Lady of Good Counsel Church where she served as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion delivering the sacrament to patients at Copley, as well as serving with the Sanctuary Sodality. Mary Ann was an avid reader and, for many years, a volunteer with the Adult Literacy Project at Waubensee.
