Mary Elizabeth Josephine Schulte Muth, 94, of Aurora passed away on Thursday, February 26th, 2015 at Sunnymere in Aurora, IL. She was born March 14, 1920 in St. Helena, NE.

Mary's career started as a country school teacher in a one room schoolhouse teaching grades 1- 8 in South Dakota. She served in the U.S. Navy as a Storekeeper Disbursing 2nd Class WAVE during WWII. She was a paraprofessional librarian at Our Lady of Good Counsel School for 25 years and continued as a volunteer for an additional 17 years. She was a member of the Our Lady of Good Counsel Church, Sanctuary Sodality, a Forester and a member of the Catholic Library Association.

She is survived by three daughters and two sons: Sharon (Ed) Jakush of Chicago, IL; Patricia Patterson of Orlando, FL; JoAnne (Randy) Zielinski of Chicago, IL; William Muth of Orient, SD and Thomas (Jill) Muth of Aurora, IL. 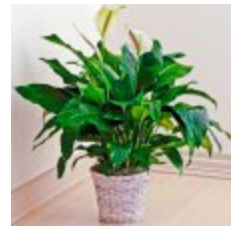
