Philomena M. Reiland, 96, of Montgomery, IL formerly of Aurora, IL, passed away Thursday, December 4, 2014. She was born August 17, 1918 in Aurora, the daughter of Mateo and Francesca (Desantis) Monaco.

Philomena lived in the Aurora area all her life, moving to Montgomery in 1968. She was the organist at Sacred Heart Church for over 60 years, and played for weddings and funerals at various churches in the area. She was a member of the Ladies of Columbus, the St. Ann Society at Sacred Heart Church, the Friendly Center Club, and the National Pastoral Musicians.

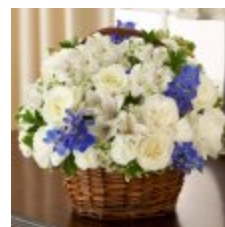
