Pilar R. Pesina, age 86 of San Antonio, TX passed away peacefully at his home on Monday, April 30th, 2012. He was born on August 22, 1925 in Santa Anna, TX. He was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather and great-grandpa. He was also a caring friend to many. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, having served during WWII. On December 15, 1949 he married the love of his life, Elidia Tomasa Jaime-Melendez and together they raised five children. They travelled the country in search of a better life for their family, from picking cotton in Texas, to working in the grape vineyards of California, finally settling in Illinois in 1966.
