Raymond P. “Whizzer” White, 92, of Aurora passed away on Saturday, November 15, 2014 at Neighbors Next Door. He was born on March 6, 1922 in Aurora, IL, the son of Alois and Mary (Konen) White.

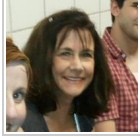
“ Dear Paul, Ken, Jim and Nancy, and families,
