Renato Flaim, 73, of Aurora, passed away Sunday, June 12, 2016 at Presence Mercy Medical Center. He was born July 31, 1942 in Tregiovo, Italy.

Renato owned and operated Walt's Bakery for many years. He retired from West Aurora School District #129 after serving as warehouse supervisor for many years, and also served as lunch room supervisor for Herget Middle School. Renato was an Army veteran and a member of the Aurora Turners Club and the Phoenix Club. He enjoyed gardening, bird watching, wine making, following the Chicago Cubs, and was a proud Nonno to his grandchildren.
