To Linda, Jane, Debbie, Carol, Mary & Paul;

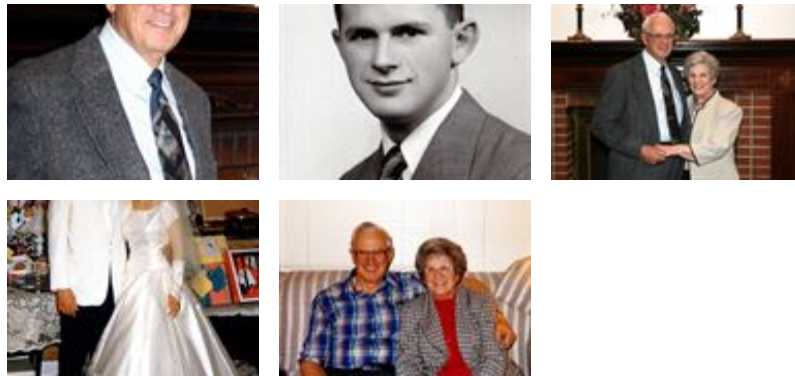
