Ronald E Carley, 77, of North Aurora, Illinois, passed away peacefully at home on July 17, 2014 surrounded by the ones he laughed with, lived for and loved. He was born March 16, 1937 on the Lac Courte Oreilles Indian Reservation in Reserve, Wisconsin.

He proudly served his country in the US Army from 1959 to 1961. After he returned home he was employed for many years as a Traffic Manager for Warner Brothers and Strathmore Printing in Geneva IL. Ronald was a lifelong member of Blessed Sacrament Church in North Aurora where he sang in the funeral choir. He was also a tribal member of the LCO Indian Reservation, a heritage he was so strongly proud of.

On April 27, 1968 he was united in marriage to his wife Linda (Webster) with whom he spent 46 wonderful years. He was an avid Green Bay Packers fan, loved playing Bingo with his circle of close friends as well as playing cards and mastering crossword puzzles.

In addition to his wife, Ronald leaves to cherish his memory daughter Jennifer (David) Houck and his grandson, Evan (aka "the boo") whom he loved, adored and was ever so proud of the young man he has become. Ron also is survived by his step brothers and sisters, several nieces and nephews.

He is preceded in death by his loving and loyal daughter Angela, brother William and sisters Eunice, Bernice and Barbara and his dear friend and fellow Packer fan Jerry Haverkate.

We thank God for the gift of Ron's life, the many dear friends he met thru the
