Ronald P. Keenan, 66, of Aurora, passed away Sunday, July 17, 2016 at Presence St. Joseph Hospital in Elgin. He was born July 20, 1949 in Aurora, Illinois.

Ronald was a Marine Corps veteran of Viet Nam. He was a member of the V.F.W. Post #7452 in Montgomery, the Am Vets Post #103, and was a member of Holy Angels Church. Ronald was employed by Caterpillar for many years until his retirement.

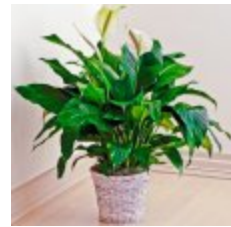
