On Friday, July 17, 2015 HWX Coxswain Rory “Bo” Reyna passed away in Grand Haven, Michigan. Rory worked at the Vaughn Center as a life guard in high school. He graduated from East Aurora High School in 2006. He attended Waubensee Community College for a short time before deciding to join the Coast Guard. Rory joined the Coast Guard in 2008 after finishing his basic training. He was stationed in Galveston, TX (2009-2012), Puerto Rico (2012-2014), and Grand Haven, MI (2014-2015). With the Coast Guard he traveled to many different places over the years.
