July 30, 1918 - February 4, 2013

Rose Comer, 94, of North Aurora, passed away Monday, February 4, 2013 at Westlake Hospital in Melrose Park, IL. She was born July 30, 1918 in Aurora, Illinois.

Rose worked for General Motors in Dayton, Ohio for 30 years until her retirement in 1978. She moved back to Aurora in 1979. Rose was the longest living member of the Women of the Moose, and was also a member of the Friendly Center and the St. Elizabeth Society.
