June 26, 1920 - October 8, 2014

Rosemary (Winckler) Bohr, of Aurora, passed away on Wednesday, October 8, 2014, at Jennings Terrace. She was born on June 26, 1920 in New Riegel, Ohio, the daughter of Edward and Mary Winckler. Rosemary attended St. Nicholas Grade School and Madonna High School. On June 22, 1940, she married her “honey”, Albert C. Bohr at St. Nicholas Church in Aurora. They spent the next 54 years of their life together until Albert’s death on March 15, 1994.

Rosemary was a homemaker. She enjoyed sewing her children’s clothing and all their Halloween costumes, baking and decorating all the birthday cakes, canning and a talent for making delicious meals with whatever was in the pantry and refrigerator.
