Terry E. Lipscomb, 69 of North Aurora passed away Tuesday, November 8, 2011 at Provena Mercy Center, Aurora, IL. He was born December 26, 1941 in Bloomington, IL.

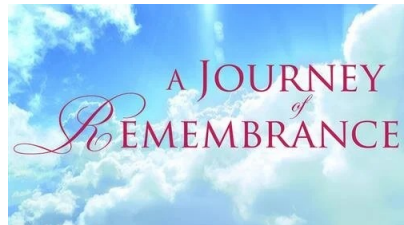
