August 9, 1926 - September 6, 2015

Victor A. Oros, 89 of Aurora passed away Sunday, September 6, 2015 at Kindred Hospital in Sycamore. He was born August 9, 1926 in Aurora, IL.

He was a lifelong, loyal and active member of St. George Church, the St. George Romanian Club and ARCA Camp. He was a United States Veteran having served in the Navy during WWII on the USS Seminole. In 1983, Victor retired from the Aurora Fire Department as a Lieutenant, after twenty seven and one half years of dedicated service. More than anything, Victor loved his family and he will be deeply missed.
