Vincent Thomas Nugent, 87, passed away Sunday, March 26, 2023 at his home in Aurora, Illinois. He was born April 12, 1935 in Serena, Illinois, the son of Leo and Florence (Grandadam) Nugent. He was preceded in death by his parents and four siblings, Edward (Florence) Nugent, Dolores (William) Bermes, Margaret (Lawrence) Lenac, and Marilyn Nugent, and by his nephew, Dennis Lenac.

Vincent and his siblings grew up on various farms in and around Serena Township. He gave the very best hugs and was the best person to nap on the couch with after a holiday feast. Bud always attended family gatherings and birthday parties for
