



Virginia C. Schindlbeck

November 29, 1915 - March 12, 2015

Virginia C. Schindlbeck, 99, of Aurora, passed away Thursday, March 12, 2015 at Presence Mercy Medical Center. She was born November 29, 1915 at home in Aurora to Italian immigrants Louise and George Olden. Virginia grew up on the “south” side of Aurora, attending South Lake Street School, Holy Angels School and then graduating from Madonna High School in 1934.

Virginia met George P. Schindlbeck just before WWII. They exchanged many letters and finally married upon his return, making their home in Aurora. They eventually purchased a little cottage in Twin Lakes, WI where they enjoyed family and friends. Virginia was a very involved member of the St. Anne’s Society, Unit 16 along with her sister-in-law Stella Olden. Virginia also loved cooking and gardening.

When her boys were in college she went back to work as a tax preparer for H&R Block, working out of the Sears store in Aurora. She went on to manage the H&R Block store in Aurora and retired at the age of 80 after 25 years of service, but continued to prepare returns out of her home until she was 89.

She is survived by her two sons, Michael G. Schindlbeck, Paul R. (Donna) Schindlbeck; two grandchildren, Timothy Schindlbeck, Sarah Schindlbeck; a sister-in-law, Phyllis Olden; many nieces and nephews.
