Walter W. Jacyno, 89, of Aurora, passed away peacefully Thursday, December 31, 2015 at his home. He was born September 7, 1926 in Poland.

At the start of World War II Walter and his family were deported to Siberia. He later attended Cadet School in Palestine under Polish and British forces. He graduated from Blackburn College in England, with a degree in Textile Management. He immigrated to the United States, became a citizen and married Ava. He was employed as a Quality Control Manager by Van Straaten, that later became BP, until his retirement.

Walter was a devoted member of St. Peter Church, and a proud member of the Polish National Alliance.
