Warren Leroy "Red" Dixon, Sr., 97, of Aurora, passed away Wednesday, September 4, 2013 at Alden of Waterford. He was born June 22, 1916 in Chicago, IL.

Red was a 70 year member of Annunciation Church. He was a Third degree member of the Knights of Columbus.

He was a U.S. Navy veteran of WW II. He was a member of the Montgomery VFW post 7452 and the American Legion Post 84. He was honored to be the Grand Marshal of the 2012 Aurora Fourth of July Parade.

He was employed by Com Ed and later he was the owner operator of Dixon Realty. He is the past president of the Aurora Real Estate Board. He was a youth football coach for thirty five years, fourteen of them in Naperville.
