William E. Foust, Jr., age 74, of Laughlin, Nevada, formerly of Aurora and Yorkville, Illinois, passed away on Monday, August 24, 2015 in Fort Mohave, Arizona after a short illness. He was born April 6, 1941 to William E. Foust, Sr. and Audrey (Waymire) Foust in Marion, Indiana.

Bill joined the United States Navy after high school and was honorably discharged in June 1963. He worked for Copley Press, retiring after over 30 years of service in the production department. He also worked for the Kendall County Sheriff's department. He was a member of the American Legion, and former member of the Aurora Jaycees. After moving to Laughlin, Nevada in 2008, he joined the Volunteers in Partnership, helping the Laughlin Chamber of Commerce with events and taking pictures.
